ACTIVITY REPORT OF 2020-2021

The academic year 2020 was a very devastating year internationally due to the onset of a pandemic disease named COVID 19. The lockdown of the country started in March 21st 2020 and continued in 3 spells and lot of campaign and online programmes about the appropriate behavior of covid 19 virus spread were organized by the state and central government medical and health departments.

During lockdown our college nss programme officers and the volunteers involved in several community service programmes from their residential places. The volunteers served the needy people with provisions and they provided vegetable packets, ricebags , supplied masks sanitizers and other needs. Dhaniyala sai ex nss volunteer served the needy with vegetables and provisions for a period of nearly 60 days from his local areas near anandapuram. Students Dileep, D. Yuvaraj, Dilli Yuvakiran, D.Lalitha Virajitha they extended their community services by campaigning about the three fundamental rules mask, sanitizer, social distancing to near by neighbours aother volunteers also nd they provided food to interstate labour by making food packs from their residence.

During COVID-19 Pandemic Services rendered by UNIT-II

- Volunteers served the needy people with provisions and vegetables.
- Tribble Area Students adopted small villages and supplied masks and sanitizers.
- Tribble Area Students distributed food packets and other groceries
- Myself distributed provisions and rice bags 30 families working in GVMC and Our Apartment.

During 2020-2021 enrollment of volunteers was bit delayed due to delay in admissions and after the online admission process for UG courses enrollment of volunteers as per the proforma from Andhra university NSS CELL was sent to the mail. (2020-2021 The volunteers enrolled are 114)

Environmental Consciousness:

Environment awareness programmes like plantation, cleanliness were organized online mode. Students were advised to keep swatchtha in their residential premises and asked them to campaign about neatness importance to the neighbouring houses and colonies. Plantation done near their houses.

Awareness programmes :

The year 2020 March onwards there is lockdown period announced to avoid spread of Pandemic Covid 19 Virus. The awareness on three basic rules wearing Mask, Maintenance of physical distance and use of sanitizer was performed by the student volunteers. They made placards saying STAY HOME STAY SAFE, MASK IS MUST and displayed. Awareness on Plantation importance, Health and hygiene awareness, awareness on swatch bharath , communicable diseases were done from their home.

Government programmes:

Swatchbharath Abhiyan:

As the situation is not supported the implementation of cleaning activities in the campus area due to lock down the student volunteers performed the activity in their villages. Ullas, Baburao, Virajitha ,R.Divyasree and few more shared their activity pictures from their villages.

During august 2020 relaxation of few rules of covid 19 pandemic all the staff visited college and worked online from the college premises. As NSS programme officers we took the initiative of Sanitizing each and every part of the college with the great support of Principal Dr v.Chandra sekhar garu. Sanitization of whole college took 3 days time and all the staff were advised to follow covid 19 appropriate behavior without fail.

Blood Donation camps

In the college we have Red ribbon club and a lecturer is given the coordinatorship for the monitoring the activities of red ribbon club. Dr T.M.A Niveditha is coordinator for red ribbon club activities. In 2020 -2021 RRC NSS of Andhra University authorities organized a rally on AIDS . The rally was a huge one with 400 students from 8 colleges and a manava haram was formed in the Siripuram junction on December1st following covid protocols. Placards on the importance of blood donation, control measures of HIV were displayed during rally.

Gender Sensitization programmes:

Gender Sensitization and awareness on gender equality, women health issues conducted in the college during 2020-2021 with the coordination of Women Empowerment cell. Dr P.Sreevani is the coordinator of WEC and the nss activity related to girl students on gender perspectives are organized on International women' s day and observation of national girl child day. During Janyuary 24th 2021 National girl child day was organized for which an NGO Balavikas foundation director Narava Prakasarao attended and created awareness on the girl child education to nss volunteers.

Special Camps and National integration camps:

In -2020 – 2021 NO Special camp is organized . But a community service project given by NSS-UNICEF joint work to our college. It is a 12 day survey project started from August 2020 to December 2020. The detail info about the project was given below. **(with respect to National camps A student from our college D.Yuvakiran got an opportunity to attend Republic Day Parade 2021 January 26th which made our college very proud.)**

Special Project On Covid 19 Appropriate behavior was sanctioned to our College by the NSS CELL Andhra University in Coordination with UNICEF organization.

The project is entitled as **RISK COMMUNITIES AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT**

This project aim at creating awareness among risk communities such as the people living in slum areas, people working as construction labourers, people of raithu bazaar, fishmarkets, People of auto communities and people moving in crowds.

This project started in August 2020 and com completed in December 2020.

At about 24 volunteers from each college were trained online and offline in the college about the objectives of RCCE to be implemented as community service.

- The objectives of RCCE are
- Every person must follow 3 basic rules of Covid 19 appropriate behavior
- Testing Tracing and Tracking must be observed if any case is detected
- Nutritious food to mother and child is must
- Respect the frontline workers during pandemic like Doctors, GVMC swatchtha team labour and Health workers.
- Create awareness about the symptoms of Covid 19 viral infection
- Awareness on precautions during Quarantine stay.
- Treatment of covid 19 effected patient at home

Project implementation training was given by Dr S.Haranadh garu and District Programme officer E.P.S. Bhagyalakshmigaru in the beginning of the project work execution. Our college was given 6 slums in and around maddilapalem. They are Relli veedhi, Rajakaveedhi, KRM colony, Durganagar colony Achamvaripeta, Simhadripuram. Each area surveyd by 2 student volunteers in every month for 2 days for a period of 6 months. The data collected in books and books were submitted to NSS OFFICE Andhra University. In addition to slums 6 worksites were choosen for creating RCCE objectives. They are Constuction site labour community, Auto community, Fisherman community, Road side vendors community, Raithu bazaar communities.
