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Activity report 2021-2022:

During 2021/2022 the nss activities in the beginning of academic year in the month of June and July mostly conducted from the home as the pandemic spread was high due to the outburst of Delta plus variant. Inspite of the covid pandemic the regular activities conducted actively by the volunteers and the programme officer.

REGULAR ACTIVITIES:

Plantation and Environmental Consciousness activities: During 2021 in the month of July plantation activities were performed by the volunteers from their villages in school premises, at their home. SPECIAL CAMP PROGRAMME

NSS Special Camp (20/02/2022 to 26/02/2022) Report

Area of camp: RAJAKA VEEDHI of Maddilapalem area

National Service Scheme Special camp is a seven day program organized in adopted slum of the choosen area by the Program officer with a prior permission from the Principal of the college, NSS Cell of the concerned University to which the college is affiliated. This programme aims at conducting community service activities such as swatch bharath, plantation, health awareness, socio economic survey of the adopted slum and organizing free medical camp in the area. The present camp is conducted in the adopted slum of maddilapalem area to inculcate awareness on the community issues, swachh bharath, water conservation, health and hygiene, Plantation and other government programs by the selected nss volunteers (49/Unit) to the residents of the adopted slums.

Prior to start of special camp a pre camp visit is performed by NSS program officers and requested the respective area in charge, community leaders , and dwakra members and took permission for organizing camp in the respective slum areas. The camp was then planned and student lists were prepared as per the NSS special camp guidelines. In addition day wise program sheets were also prepared for proper execution of the camp.

Each day during camp will have two sessions (morning and afternoon session) with a lunch break for one hour. The activities planned in morning session include cleaning of the slum, Plastic free environment, Swachh pakhwada, Awareness programs on UNICEF objectives (Child marriages, Child trafficking, Nutrition and Anaemia issues, Drug abuse) village socio economic survey , conducting free medical checkups, Eye camps and rallies on drug abuse and other community aspects. After the morning session lunch will be served for all the volunteers and invited guests.

In the afternoon session Awareness orientation programs on life skills, Communication skills, Environmental issues, Blood donation activities and UNICEF objectives will be organized for the NSS volunteers by renowned resource persons from various educational institutes. After the sessions the volunteers perform skits on social issues like child marriages, child trafficking etc and also participate in cultural activities by exhibiting their talents. Thus the special camp program is very useful for improving the personality development of the NSS Volunteers.

The present camp was organized in a community hall of Ambedkar colony near to Rajaka Veedhi of HB colony. The President of the community hall Sri P. Venkateswarrao garu helped us in giving the shelter for conducting various NSS activities during camp.

Day 1: Date: 20/02/2022

On Day 1 Inaugural session was organized in Ambedkar Bhavanam of Ambedkar Colony near the adopted slum Rajaka veedhi of HB colony of Visakhapatnam. Invitees for the program are the Principal of Dr V.S. Krishna Govt. Degree College, Dr I. Vijayababu garu -President of the Function, Dr S. Haranadh garu , NSS Coordinator- Andhra University, Sri Molli Apparao garu, Corporator of Maddilapalem, Sri P.Venkateswarrao, President of Ambedkar Bhavanam, Vice Principal of the college, Dr Chada Sastry garu, IQAC Coordinator Dr Ch. Lalitha who graced the camp. All the dignitaries addressed the NSS volunteers and motivated them with their speeches. All the volunteers gathered at ambedkar bhavan Bhavan by 8.30 AM .and made arrangements by tying banners and posters for inaugural function.

After the inauguration unit wise few volunteers were taken and Committees were framed by the Programme officers. Different committees of the Special camp are 1. Swachh Bharath committee 2. Discipline Committee 3. Attendance Committee 4. Food and water service Committee 5. Programm execution committee 6. Cultural Committee.

On day 1 all the volunteers performed Swatchtha Programe in the govt degree college by cleaning all the 30 class rooms and inner campus of the college. It was a big task and several tools like broom sticks,

plant cutters to cut the weeds in the garden areas were used. Volunteers were given gloves and dustbin covers to collect the scrap and wastes. The whole garbage was collected by GVMC van. This activity is mainly done in the college because the college is near to the adopted slums area. After swatchtha program the students learned the NSS song and other patriotic songs.

Day 2 Date: 21/02/2022

Swach bharath was a major task is given to clean the adopted slum premises of Ambedkar colony. The camp place cleaning is a daily program. Before the forenoon session starts all the students do prayer Vandemataram and start doing the allotted works. To clean the camp area broom sticks were used by all the volunteers and for about three hours students worked in the allotted place. The team leaders divided the volunteers into groups and were given gloves and broom sticks for cleaning the streets. Students collected plastic, cleared the blocked drainages, sweeped the roads and few of them performed door to door campaign about swach bharath.

Lunch was given as per the schedule. After the community service and lunch a talk was organized for the volunteers on **THE THEME OF NSS and role of youth in National Service Scheme.** Dr Manikya kumara garu a state NSS program officer awardee from St.Joseph Degree College to deliver a lecture on the theme given. After the talk student interaction was done and volunteers honoured madam with boquet and fruits. After the talk students performed folk dances depicting the culture of Andhra Pradesh.

Day 3 : 22/02/2022

As programmed in the plan day 3 started with a prayer and cleaning of the premises. Later all the students were given the **village survey format**. Total 4 slums were choosen around the ambedkar colony for all the units of the special camp. They are 1. KRM colony 2. Relli veedhi3. Rajaka veedhi 4. Ambedkar colony.

The survey of around 100 houses was performed on the whole day. The survey include key points about the govt schemes allotment in time or not any issues regarding the health , covid vaccination, other important issues. The student volunteers performed this activity very sincerely and collected the data.

After lunch again students involved in collecting the data and also gave awareness to the residents about health and hygiene , child marriages, compulsory education to all children and govt shemes for improving the lives of the youth. End of Day 3 Students performed skits and other cultural activities.

Day 4: 23/02/2022

On day4 the activities started with prayer and cleaning of the premises. A health camp was organized by the program officer for the residents of the colony by NTR Trust and Agarwal Eye Hospital Institute. NTR blood bank medical officers Dr Balakrishna garu checked the blood pressure and sugar of the residents and gave nutrition and vitamin tablets to the needed patients. In addition blood tests Haemoglobin test was also performed and nearly 60 people checked the health. Eye checkup camp also

done simultaneously to detect the eye problems in the colony. The ophthalmologists gave the receipts to patients for free eye checkup and cataracts.

In the Afternoon session after the lunch Indira Gandhi National Best NSS volunteer awardees were invited to the camp to create motivation and inspiration for all the volunteers for their better performance in NSS activities. Dhaniyala Sai IGN awardee of 2021 and Leela Prasad reddy of IGN Awardee 2017 interacted with the students and explained the various opportunities in NSS and how the volunteers can attain the highest awards with their hardwork and interest in doing community service. Dhaniyala Sai received was student of Dr V.S.Krishna Govt. Degree College during the year 2016-2019. He attended all the NSS activities, special camps, mega camps and National integration Camps during his tenure as volunteer in the college. With the active participation as volunteer he secured a seat in MA Economics in Andhra University7 where he continued as volunteer further. He was choosen as best volunteer by the National NSS committee from Andhra University and became IGN awardee in 2021.

Leela Prasad is another service motto person who actively involved in Nehru Yuvakendra Activities. He also interacted with the volunteers and both the awardees were honoured by the special camp team. After the interaction the awardees served the students with snacks and fruities.

Day 5: 24/02/2022

Day 5 of the camp started with Morning prayer and cleanliness. The volunteers performed a vaccination survey in the four adopted slums of the maddilapalem and HB colony areas. In addition they also performed the awareness on the plastics, cleanliness of the surrounding sto avoid various communicable diseases, preventing measures of certain communicable diseases.

In the afternoon session a talk on ENVIRONMENT CONSCIOUNESS by a social service organization named Green Climate organization. The director of the organization Sri Ratnam Garu discussed various issues of the environment, dry and wet waste management, seed balls to develop social forestry, etc. Later Ratnam garu visited the college campus and taught the students to make nursery by sowing seeds and twigs of various plants.

After the session student volunteers actively participated in interactive sessions with resourse persons and program officers and lastly active participation in dance music and skits etc as part of cultural programs.

Day 6 25/06/2022

This day was spent for the important event AZADI KI AMRUTH MAHOTSAV. 75 years of independence celebrations. Few volunteers dressed as the patriotic famous leaders of independence include MAHATMA GANDHI, Sardar Vallabhbhai patel, Bhagath sing, Alluri Seetharamaraju, Subhash Chandra Bose, Swami Vivkananda, Sarojani Nidu, IndiraGandhi costumes for indicating the famous leaders of India.

The motivating talks of the freedom fighters were memorized by the show of the volunteers and the program was encouraged by the Principal Dr I Vijaya Babu garu and Vice Principal Dr Chada Sastry garu.

Validitory function organized by the program officers this day as there was another important event on day 7 26/02/2022 that is International Science day in the college.

Prof NAD Pal, Director of Academic staff college invited as chief guest for the valedictory function. Principal Dr I. Vijaya Babu, Community leaders Molli Apparao garu, P. Venkateswararao garu, Vice Principal Chada Sastry garu, IQAC coordinator Dr Ch.Lalitha, Academic Coordinator Dr P. R Vani, Dr G. Rajasekhar, Sri Rajarao and the Program officers Dr V. Ratnabharathi, P. Umamaheswararao, Dr V.Sudheer, dr T.S.D. Raj organized and attended the valediction. The various services performed by the volunteers during camping time were appreciated and all the volunteers were given the books of swami Vivekananda along with other gifts. Ch. Lalitha madam gave sweets and fruitees to all the volunteers on the last day of the special camp. Kondalarao office staff provided chicken in lunch to all volunteers.
