3) The time taken for grievance redressal would depend upon the nature and severity of the complaint and the resources available for the redressal.

It may take minimum seven working days to solve minor complaints and even more for serious grievances.






As per the representation dated 13-02-2022, the class representatives have requested to rectify the leakage of water from taps in girls washrooms.

1) It is resolved to identify the problems of students by asking each class to give their representation through their class representatives (CR). They can also represent to their class mentors. If the grievance is serious or personal they can also meet the principal or the committee members directly.

2) They can also drop their grievances in writing in the grievance box provided in the first floor of Science block near Botany department.

4) The grievance committee may also consider the grievances of staff and parents.

5) The grievances received via online (or) offline would be examined by the committee members and then discuss with the Principal. Finally they will arrive at the measures to be taken for the redressal.

6) The committee members need to look into the follow up action and to see that the grievance is completely redressed.

7) The time to be taken for the grievance redressal will depend on the nature and severity of the complaint. It also will depend on the resources that are available for redressal. It may take seven working days to solve the minor problems and even more

The discipline committee is also instructed to restrict the entry of outsiders into the college campus.


