- 1) Implement the Autonomous Education System as per the staff council's proceedings commencing from this academic year 2024-25 for the admitted batch of 1st year degree students of 2023-24.
- 2) Implement guidelines of the Academic Council.
- 3) Approve and ratify the syllabus for various semesters under CBCS from 2024-25 academic year onwards.
- 4) Ratify the General English and Special English syllabus for the academic year 2024-25.
- 5) Approve and ratify the first-year syllabus of B.A/B.Com/B.Sc/BBA Logistics and first year syllabus for the admitted batch of 2024-25.
- 6) Approve and ratify Skill Enhancement Course (Inter Disciplinary Course).
- 7) Introduce Add-on course title "Enhancing English Proficiency" for I-year Students.

- 8) Conduct Seminars, Workshops and Students Centered Activities.
- 9) Adapt Quality based curriculum as per the norms of the NAAC.
- 10) Encourage students to join JKC/TISS/MOOCs programs to equip them with adequate skill sets in communication and also to develop their personality.
- 11) Encourage students to participate in community centric activities like health programs.
- 12) Implement classroom activities guided and graded on the basis of Bloom's Taxonomy.
- 13) Setting up of question paper is also guided by the principles of Bloom's Taxonomy (recalling, understanding, applying, analyzing, evaluating and creating).
- 14) Implement Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and Evaluation for mid semester and semester end exams. The mid semester examination (IA) is assessed for 100 marks (2 Mid semesters of 50 marks each exam), and reduced /scale down to 40 marks and external examinations is for 60 marks. The final total at the end of semester is 100 marks.
- 15) Approve and ratify the Question paper blue print, Model question paper and the system of Internal Assessment for semester 1 to 2 for General English and semester 1 to 6 for Special English (w.e.f 2024-25 admitted batch)
- 16) Encourage the students to undertake Community Service Project (CSP) for 1st years, Internship for 2nd years and On-Job Training for 3rd year students to actively participate during their course of study.

- 17) Approve and ratify the syllabus for Business Writing Sem-III – Skill Enhancement course.
