


Teacher feedback analysis report 2021-22

Alumni feedback analysis report 2021-22


Feedback from alumni will be taken during "ALUMNI MEET" and total 20 alumni members submitted their feedback.

Parent feedback analysis report 2021-22

Feedback from parents will be taken during Parent-Teacher Meet or when parents visit the college departments for general enquiry about their wards.

Focus on the Parent Feedback Form

The parent's feedback form focuses on the following issues:

- 1. Does their ward informed them about their performance in the college
- 2. Library and canteen facilities
- 3. Learning experience of the student in JKC and other job oriented trainings
- 4. Add on courses and examination system
- 5. Sports

Feedback was collected from 178 parents during the year. 93% of the parents appreciated the awareness programmes and training programmes organized in the college. 91% of the parents have found the college JKC and other job oriented trainings useful and important. 70% of parents are satisfied with examinations and value added courses. 97% of the parents found the sports and extracurricular activities are good. Parents suggested to improve the career counselling to create more awareness on their future.

- 1. Parents are satisfied with the good infrastructure of the college and have found it to be safe and secure for their children.
- 2. Parents also found that the children have a good learning experience in the college as a result of the good knowledgeable faculties teaching the children.

Recommendations and suggestions:


- 1. It was suggested that there would be more resources provided in the library and an improvement made in the facility provided by the sports department.
