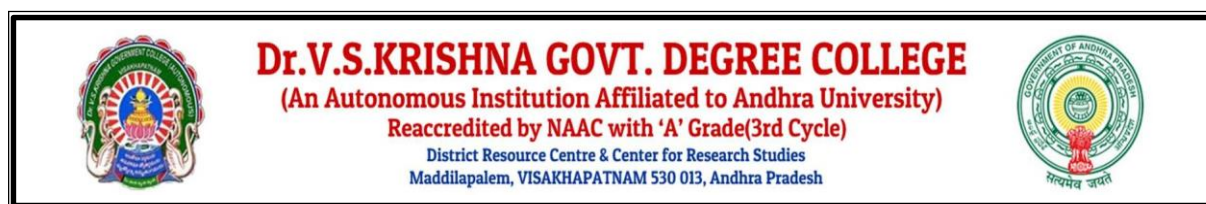

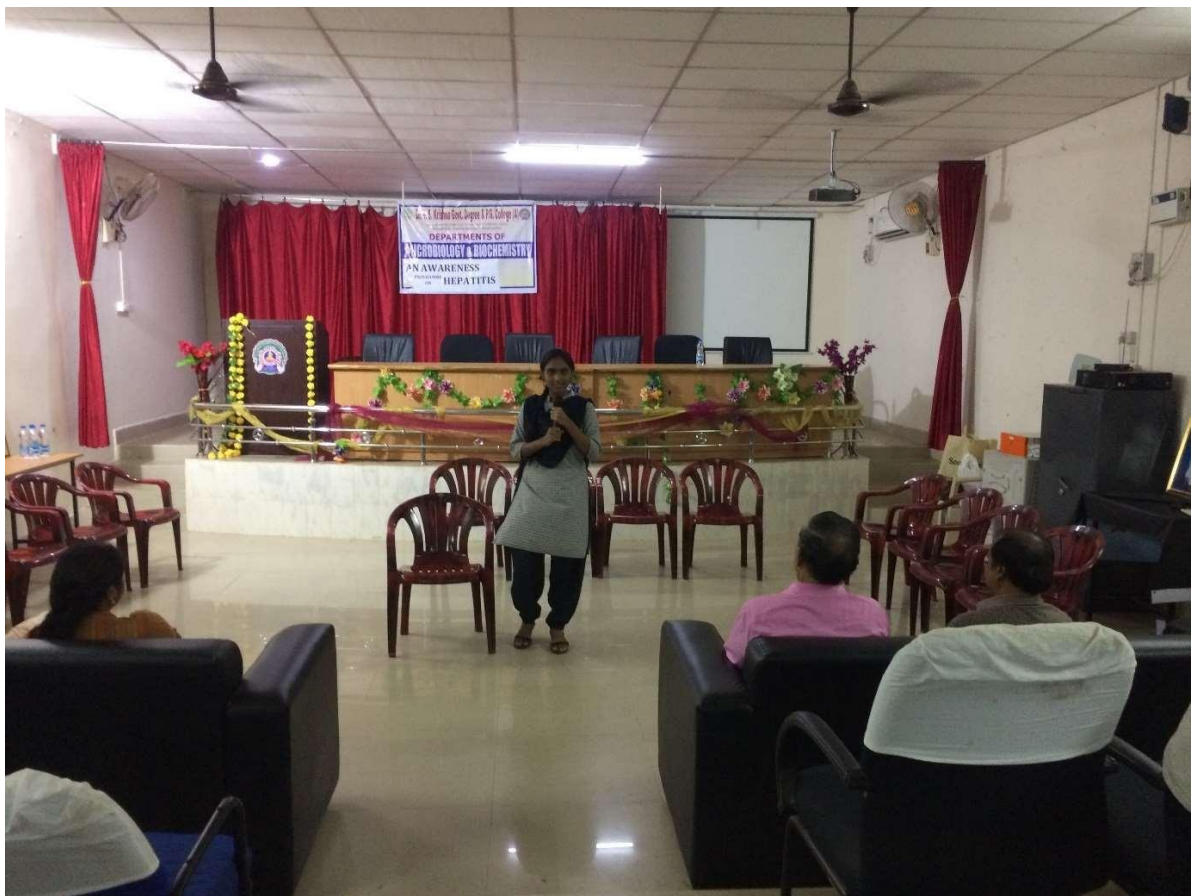

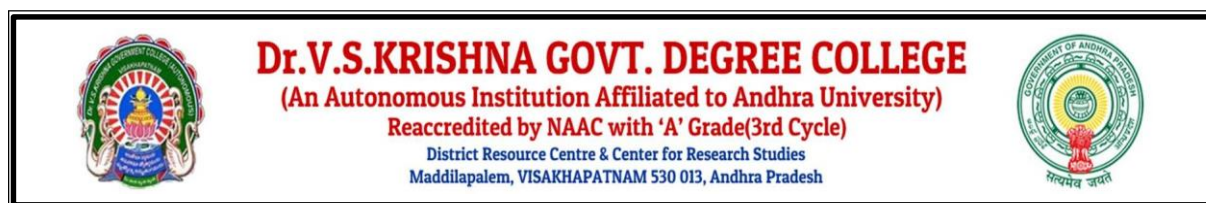

Outcome of the Event	Most of the people thought that this is an outdated disease and is not existing now. But they came to know about its existence.





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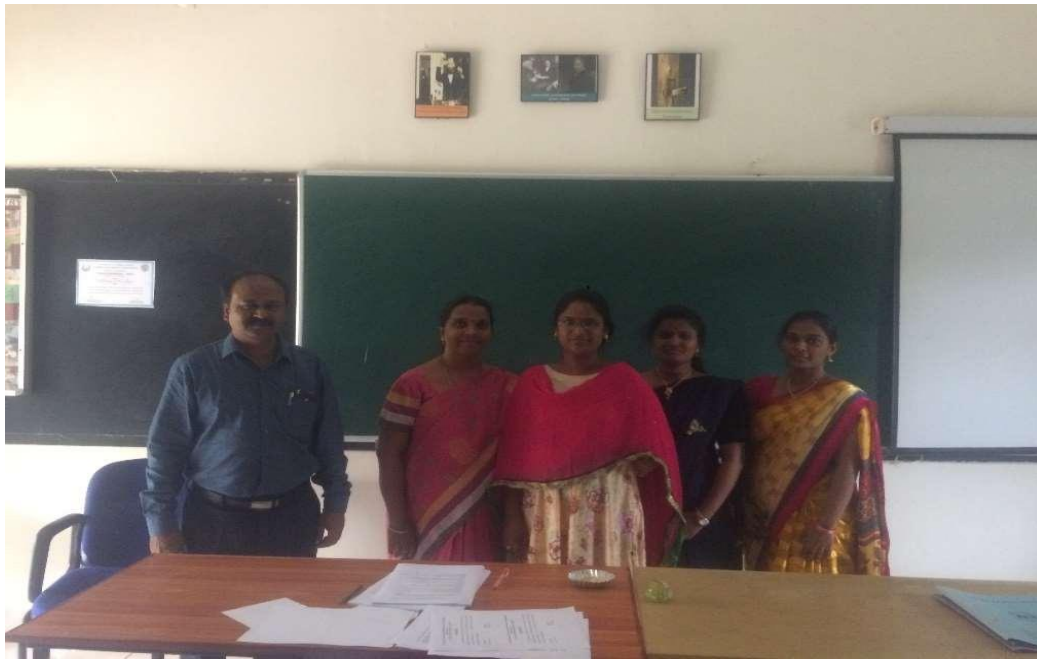
