The Board of Studies shall recommend the following to the Academic Council:

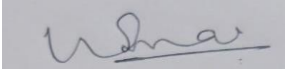
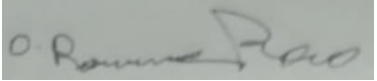
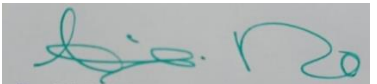

## **Resolutions/ Minutes of the 9<sup>th</sup> Board of Studies August-2023-24**

The Board of Studies of Department of SANSKRIT, Dr. V.S. Krishna Govt degree College(A) met on 11-09- 2023 and resolved the following:

Resolved to

1. Implement the Autonomous Education system as per the staff council's proceedings commencing from the academic year 2023-24 for the admitted batch of 1<sup>st</sup> year degree students of 2023-24 only.
2. To implement guidelines of the academic council.
3. Approve and introduce the newly framed syllabus modified and approved by the Board of Studies (BOS) for the first year 2023-24 Degree course in SANSKRIT.
4. Approval and Ratification of changes/modifications in curriculum design for 1 & 2 Semesters under Choice Based Credit System from 2023-24 academic year onwards given by APSCHE.
5. Approval of new employable and skill based programmes from 2023-24.
6. Ratify and introduced new semester mode pattern of exam for students with the following combinations and courses B.A, B.Sc & B.Com, SANSKRIT subject Further it is approved and ratified the model question papers submitted by the concerned faculty members for all the semesters. The evaluation of internal will be done for 40 Marks (Internal Assessment, Assingnment / seminar) and External assessment is for 60 Marks.
7. Conduct Seminars, Workshops, etc...
8. Adapt quality based curriculum as per the norms of the NAAC.
9. Encourage the students to join JKC to equip with communication skills and improve their personality development.
10. Encourage students to participate in community centric activities like health programmes and tie -up with reputed organizations.
11. Encourage students to participate in community service activities like NSS programmes and tie -up with reputed organizations.
12. This course aims to get students acquainted with classical sanskrit literature poetry. It intends to give an understanding of Literature, through which students will be able to appreciate the development of Sanskrit literature. The course also six to help students to negotiate texts independently.
13. Knowledge on the followings: This course aims at getting the students acquainted with the general outlines of classical Sanskrit Literature (Poetry & Prose) through Classical text. This course aims to get students acquainted with classical sanskrit literature poetry. It intends to give an understanding of Literature, through which students

will be able to appreciate the development of Sanskrit literature. The course also aims to help students to negotiate texts independently.

14. This course aims to get the students to know the basics of Sanskrit Grammar, including rules of Sandhi, Samasa, and Vibhaktiyarth Prakarana based on siddhantakaumudi, a primer of Paninian grammar. Besides, the students will be able to translate sentence and write short paras in Sanskrit.
15. Creating a language environment for students to acquire the language skills assessed by their conversation and usage of the language.
16. **Personality Development:** Help shaping cognitive, affective and behavioral abilities of students for building responsible academic professionals and researchers.
17. It is discussed and approved **the curriculum, blue print and model paper** for 1st year course under CBCS for the admitted batch 2023 -24(I & II Semesters)
18. It is discussed and approved **the curriculum, blue print and model paper** for II year under CBCS for the admitted batch 2022 -23 (III Semester)
19. a) It is discussed and approved the syllabus and model paper of Certificate Course of Management skills through Bhagavadgita. This course to be offered in I semesters students only  
b) It is discussed and approved the syllabus and model paper of Certificate Course of "Sarala" Course in Sanskrit. This course to be offered in II semesters students only
20. It is discussed and approved the proposed modification in the syllabus (15-20%) of Sanskrit semester I and II for the academic year 2023-24.
  - a. It is discussed and approved Additional Syllabus is added in Semester I  
Unit- V Introduced Eminent Ancient Scholars- KUMARASMBHAVAM 1<sup>ST</sup> CANTO
  - b. It is discussed and approved one Topic has been added in Semester II  
Unit-V KARNABHARAM OF BHASA
7. It is discussed and approved Each theory subject is evaluated for 100 Marks out of which 60 Marks through semester end examination and internal assessment would be for 40 Marks for 2022-23 and 2023-24 admitted batches. The minimum pass mark for external examinations is 21 marks

(35%), but as a whole student should obtain 40% marks (40 out of total 100 marks) to pass the subject.

- Mid-I examination is to be conducted for 30 marks and scaled down to 20 marks
- Mid-II examination to be conducted for 30 marks and scaled down to 15 marks
- 5 marks for assignment, 5 marks for seminar and 5 marks for clean and green are allotted.

As 40 marks are allotted for internal assessment, these 50 marks are to be scaled down to 40 marks.
