IQAC ANNUAL REPORT 2018-19

The college is re-accredited by NAAC with "**A**" grade at **3.11 CGPA** in 4 point scale. In this academic year (2018-19) UGC expert committee visited our college and granted autonomy (2nd cycle) for another period of 6 years from 2017-18 to 2022-23. This College **secured 80th rank** in 2017 **and 162nd rank** in 2018 in NIRF rankings at All India level. Annual Academic and Administrative Audit team visited our College and given '**A**' Grade.



INFRASTRUCTURE:

The College has 30 class rooms, 3 A/C seminar halls, 11 e-class rooms. This college equipped with 2 computer labs, 1 English Language lab, 1 JKC computer lab and 1 MANA tv class room. In addition to BSNL net work, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh Provided 100 mbps and 10 mbps leased lines for Inter-net facility through Ap fibre Grid. More over this college has 4 virtual class rooms and 3 digital class rooms for interaction with other colleges globally.

Participation in Video conferences and LIVE tv shows are possible through virtual class room.

ADMISSIONS:

The academic year started in the month of **June** with the 1st year admissions of the college. The college had a tough time to meet the demand for seats in various courses because this is the only Govt. Autonomous College in the city with Co-education, having the best infrastructure and quality Curricular facilities in Zone-I. The total number of students studying in the present academic year including UG and PG is **2100** out of which **1140** are boys and **960** are girls.

SCHOLARSHIPS :

The students of Dr.V.S.Krishna Govt. Degree College(A) are getting benefited by various types of scholarships from both Government & Non-government agencies basing on their merit & Corporate Social Responsibility.

Apart from Govt. Scholarships, the total amount generated from other agencies during this year was about more than 1 Crore. This is the special attractive opportunity of this college.

RESULTS :

The College is recognised as the best autonomous college in the state with good pass percentage every year. During 2017-18 academic year the College got 76%, with B.A.77%, B.Com 85.7% ,B.Sc. Maths Stream 66% and B.Sc., Biology stream 76.5%.

RESEARCH :

The research centre, the gift of Andhra University is gearing up well with a total of 14 Ph.Ds and 3 M.Phils so far awarded since its inception(2014 onwards).

Student Progression:

Most of the students get shortlisted in the campus drives (about 40 %) and the percentage of AUCET & other qualifying entrance exams is also high (about 20 %). The vertical progression of the students is very healthy in this institution. The students of this College are also benefited by 13 job oriented add-on courses with value added skills. We are also maintaining about 33 best practices to improve the academic standards of the college.

STATE BEST TEACHER AWARDS : Dr.Ch.Lalitha, Lecturer in Microbiology and Dr.P.Sreevani , Lecturer in Botany got A.P.State Best teacher awards for the year 2018.

K.Geetha got 1st prize in Sankranthi Sambaralu conducted by Miriyala Venkata Rao foundation at Zonal level.


SPORTS :
