IQAC 2020-21 - ANNUAL REPORT

1. Dr.V.S.Krishna Government Degree College (Autonomous), Visakhapatnam obtained rank in NIRF within 150-200 rank band among colleges. The institution also secured 1st Rank among state level Autonomous Colleges and 5th Rank at National level in “Education World” : Government Autonomous Colleges Ranking 2020-21.
2. All the faculty conducted classes in online platforms such as Google meet, Zoom, CISCO Webex etc and prepared the students for the semester examinations, during the Covid-19 pandemic.
3. The faculty of English, Botany, Sanskrit , Zoology and so on organized online quiz and students have participated actively in the activities conducted. Students webinars organized by Botany, Computer Science, Physics and Microbiology departments.
4. The Nodal JKC has been relentlessly working for imparting training and honing skills of the UG students to turn them into quality human resources under the able leadership of CCE, Government of Andhra Pradesh. JKC has introduced “JKC TALKS” a complete skilling programme apart from the regular JKC curriculum, which includes the prominent 21st century skill set like Presentation skills, Interview skills, Time Management and Group discussions and so on for making students aspirants to be job ready.
5. Faculty have been providing online coaching for competitive examinations such as PG entrance, general knowledge, mental ability etc. Course content and mock tests are circulated in the student groups.
6. The department of Zoology organized International webinar on “ANIMAL ETHICS & HUMAN GENOMICS “ on 05-08-2020. Dr.P.Uma Devi, Research Instructor, Virginia University from USA delivered key note address and shared her research experience with students & staff.
7. The college celebrated Independence Day on 15-08-2020 with limited members of staff and students. The students of Microbiology presented a poster on Independence Day online.


8. The departments of Microbiology & Biochemistry organised a National webinar on "Diagnostics and Therapeutics of Covid-19 Pandemic - Current Issues and Challenges" on 18-08-2020. Prof.T.Sai Gopal, HOD, Virology, SV University, Tirupathi and Dr.K.Parthasaradhi, Scientist-D , Centre for Drug Discovery and Development, Satyabhama Institute of Technology, Chennai shared valuable research information.
9. Lt.V.A.Swami Naidu, Librarian, Dr.V.S.Krishna Govt. Degree College(A), Visakhapatnam organised webinar on usage of NDLI user awareness programme on NDLI on 07-09-2020. Dr.L.Vignesh, Director, NDLI, IIT Kharagpur created awareness to the staff & students in usage of NDLI during pandemic situation.

12. The college has gone for ISO certification on 14-09-2020. The representative from HYM International, Hyderabad visited the campus and instructed certain measures, protocols and advised to keep display boards for some standard operating procedures and policies.
13. Semester end examinations for sem-2,4 & 6 students were held from 28-09-2020 to 06-10-2020 for sem-6, from 19-10-2020 to 31-10-2020 for sem-4 & 2 in 2 sessions.
14. Offline classes were started from November 2020 for semester-3 and semester-5 of 2020-21 academic year. Classwork is done by both online and offline ways. Teachers are instructed to complete the syllabus by 15th February. Faculty have taken extra classes to compensate the lost classes due to various reasons during pandemic. Semester end examinations were conducted from 03-2021 to 02-2021 for semester-3 and 5.
15. Circle Inspector Ramanayya voluntarily interacted with the girl students on 13-11-2020, addressed all the girl students and advised to install "DISHA app" into the mobile of girl students to ensure their safety.
16. The college invited health department to conduct Covid-19 tests in the campus to enable screening of staff & students infected with covid-19 on 18-11-2020. Civil Assistant Surgeon from District Medical Health Centre conducted tests as a part of tracing and tracking. 2 students got positive with no symptoms. But they are advised and given prescription to control the infection. Principal suspended offline classes for 4 days and all the rooms in the campus were sanitized.

22. The government of Andhra Pradesh announced that the admissions will be done online at state level for the academic year 2020-21. Dr.VSKGDC(A) offers 22 programmes for the year 2020-21. 15 programmes are continued from previous academic years. 7 programmes are newly offered from the current year. B.Sc Maths/Computer Science/Statistics, B.Sc Physics, B.Sc Chemistry, B.Com Computer Applications, B.Com Taxation& Finance, B.A Economics, BMS Maritime Logistics and B.Voc Aquaculture.
23. Cup of Rice Programme was conducted on 08-01-2021 with the initiative of IQAC. Rice donated by the staff and students is gathered and offered to orphanages. This year 14 bags of rice are donated to Papa Homes and 14 bags of rice to Care n Love Orphanage home. The chief guest Prof. Hari Prakash (Director, SDC.AU) & Dr.S.Harinath NSS Programme Coordinator, Andhra University graced the occasion.
24. Board of studies meeting was conducted on 28-01-2021. Revised Curriculum Framework in all the subjects, Life Skills, Skill Development Courses and some Minor Courses in Honors Programmes got approved as per the APSCHE guidelines issued to the autonomous institutions.
25. Prapancha Mathrubhasha Dinosthavam was celebrated by the department of Telugu on 23-02-2021.
26. Celebrated international Women's Day on 08-03-2021. Dr.P.Usha, Director , Durgabai deshmukh Study Centre, Andhra University graced the occasion as chief guest.
27. Admissions for the academic year 2020-21 completed successfully with 100% admissions in 21 programmes. Total intake is 850 and admitted is 850.
28. 7th Academic council meeting was conducted online through google meet 25.03.2021.
29. Student Induction programme(SIP) "DEEKSHARAMBH" was conducted for I year B.A,B.Com and B.Sc students on 27.03.2021.
