IQAC 2021-22- ANNUAL REPORT

1. Online webinar on "Promoting Critical Thinking through reading strategies among second language learners" was conducted by the department of English on 30-06-2021 in association with Jaffna Science Association , Srilanka .
2. Due to second wave of Covid-19 pandemic and its prevalence in the city all the faculty decided to conduct classes for semester-1,4,6 online for 2020-21 academic year batch and uploaded the day wise work done with video recordings of class and student attendance into Bharath Padhe and LPMS on apcce website.
3. The college has provided training programmes to the faculty to conduct online classes using virtual platforms such as Google meet, CISCO Webex, zoom, teachmint apps etc and to complete the syllabus.
4. Online Teaching Learning Practices (OTLP) mobile app was installed by all the faculty as per the directions of CCE and uploading the day wise work done report as per the proforma.
5. Syllabus was completed for theory as well as practical in both online and offline modes depending on the feasibility of students.
6. The sem-1 examinations have commenced from 04-08-2021. All the lecturers are instructed to attend the examination duties without fail.
7. A webinar on "Importance of Intellectual Property Rights in Research" was conducted on 06-08-2021. Dr.M.S.Shivakiran , Chief Executive Officer , Atal Incubation Centre , India addressed the staff & students.
8. The semester end examinations for semester – 4 & 6 were conducted from 18-08-2021 to 26-08-2021.
9. The Government of Andhra Pradesh, in principle, proposed to offer all UG programs from the Academic year 2021-22 in English medium only. (Cir No.APSCHE/AC/UG Courses/2021-22 dated 14-06-2021). In view of this initiation , the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education invited proposal for rationalization of UG/PG programmes.
 - i) Closure of existing unviable programs - BMS Maritime logistics (an apprentice-based programme) got very poor response in online admissions 2020-21. So it is unanimously decided to close the programme for 2021-22.
 - ii) Conversion of existing programs form Telugu to English Medium
B.A TM with 60 intake, B.Com TM with 80 intake, MPC TM with 40 intake, MPCs TM with 40 intake, and BZC with 60 intake are merged with English medium.
10. First vaccination drive was conducted for students on 21-08-2021 by health department in the campus and given covid-19 vaccine at free of cost to the students and the staff.
11. An invited talk was given by Dr Nandani Salaria IFS, National zoological park, Vizag during the celebrations of Wild life week 2021 organised by the department of zoology on 05-10-2021.


12. Observation of days such as Gurajada Apparao Jayanthi & Valmiki Jayanthi were celebrated by the department of Telugu.
13. NSS volunteers celebrated Jananna Swatcha Sankalpam, Rashtriya Ektha Divas and awareness programme on AIDS and Tuberculosis.
14. Second vaccination drive was conducted for students in the month of November 2021 by health department in the campus and given covid-19 vaccine at free of cost to the students and the staff.
15. IQAC of the College has introduced the “**QUALITY LECTURE SERIES** “ by involving experienced faculty and resource persons in delivering topics related quality enhancement of Teaching-Learning process. An invited talk on "Outcome based learning" by Dr.K.V.Ramana Rao, NAAC advisor was organised on 02-11-2021. Dr.G.Srinivas has delivered a talk on “Integration of ICT for effective pedagogy”on 03-12-2021.
