BOARD OF STUDIES (BoS) RESOLUTIONS FOR A.Y. 2022 – 2023 (MINUTES OF THE MEETING)

The Board of Studies of the Department of Physics met on 28.09.2022 at 10.00AM under the Chairmanship of Dr. CVSS Sastry and resolved the following:

- 1) To adopt Revised Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) as per the Staff Councils proceedings commencing from the academic year 2022 2023 for Semester I, II, III, IV, V and VI of B.Sc. Students.
- 2) To approve and introduce the newly framed syllabus (modified and approved by the BoS) for Semester I, II, III, IV, V and VI courses in Physics. The newly framed syllabus is oriented in such a fashion that it caters to the needs of the students and to meet the present-day job employability and to develop professionalism in the field of Physics.
- 3) To ratify and introduce the semester mode pattern of examinations for Semester I, II, III, IV, V and VI students (M.P.C., M.P.Cs, PHY-HONS and CHEM-HONS groups). Further it is approved and ratified syllabus, blue print and the model question papers submitted by the concerned faculty members for Semester I, II, III, IV, V and VI.
- 4) To approve and ratify value-added certificate course for the academic year 2022 2023.
- 5) To approve and ratifynew employable and skill-based programs from 2022 2023. To adopt NAAC norms by introducing quality circles among student community.
- 6) To approve and ratify life skill courses (LSCs), skill development courses (SDCs) for the 1st and 2nd year students (B.A., B.Com. and B.Sc.) and Physics minors for Chem. (Hons.).
- 7) To approve and ratify Community Services Project (CSP) at end of II and IV semester for 2022 2023.
- 8) To approve and ratify question paper blue print, model question papers for 75 external marks and 25 internal marks for core courses.

- To approve and ratify blue print and the model question papers for 50 external marks for life skill courses (LSCs) and skill development courses (SDCs).
- 10) To approve and ratify blue print and the model question papers for 75 external marks and 25 internal marks for skill Enhancement courses (SECs).
- 11) To approve and ratify list of examiners.
- 12) To approve suggestions for innovative teaching, learning and evaluation techniques.
- 13) To approve suggestions for students' seminars, workshops and student-centered activities.
- 14) To approve suggestions for research and extension activities or start-up.
- 15) To encourage students to take up independent research projects at their level by providing facilities.
- 16) To adopt NAAC norms by introducing quality circles among student communities.
- 17) To develop infrastructure facilities in the department and implement guidelines of the academic council.
- 18) To take up ICT mode of teaching and evolve techniques that are easily understanding by the students and conduct remedial coaching to the below average students.
- 19) To encourage students to join JKC to equip with communication skills and improve their personality development.
- 20) To encourage students to participate in the community development activities such as Haritha Krishna Eco Club, NCC and NSS.

RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED BY BOARD OF STUDIES (BoS)OF PHYSICS (2021 -2022)

The Board of studies of Physics Department met on 28.09.2022 and unanimously resolved the following:

Resolved

- 1) To continue implementation of the Autonomous Education system in CBCS pattern assuggested by APCHE model as per the staff council resolution.
- 2) To implement the guidelines of the Academic Council.
- 3) To approve the syllabus, model Question Papers and Blue Prints for first, second, third, fourth, fifth and sixth semesters of B.Sc. Degree course in Physics subject.
- 4) To approve the credits allotted and weekly workload proposed for the above syllabus. External evaluation is done for 75 marks and internal evaluation for 25 marks. The average of two mid-term examination marks secured by each student should be taken towards 25% weightage of total 100 marks. The remaining marks of internal assessment is made by conduct of assignment/project/seminar/NSS to be conducted semester wise.
- 5) To approve the continuous internal assessment pattern in accordance with SOP issued by APCCE. At least one-mid/assignment / may be conducted through online, faculty can use technical tools for evaluation and records of every student should be documented for reference.
- 6) To approve the conduct of seminars, webinars, workshops, conferences, symposia, field visits, quiz competitions etc.
- 7) To improve the curriculum as per norms of National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).
- 8) To encourage the participation of students in community centric activities.
- 9) To encourage students to get trained by JKC in Communication Skills, Analytical Skills and Life Skills etc.
- 10) To improve teacher participation in Research and extension activities.
- 11)To encourage students' participation in e-classes/virtual classes/MOOCs/SWAYAM/COURSERA/NPTEL On-line courses etc.
- 12) To make CCE LMS/ MANA TV lessons accessible to students on-line/off-line.
- 13) To conduct remedial coaching for academically weak students and to conduct advanced tutorials for fast learners.
